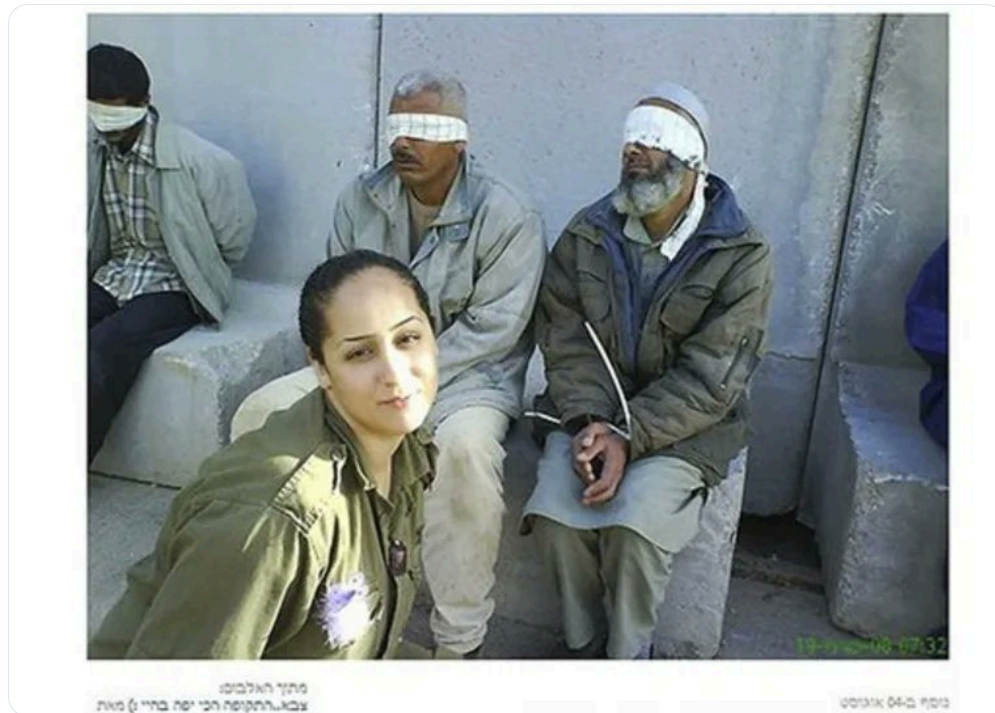

🇮🇱 Israel's Knesset is advancing a bill to execute Palestinian prisoners, led by Minister Itamar Ben Gvir. The final text has been published. Here's what it contains: 🇮🇱



2/ The bill mandates execution within 90 days of sentencing — with NO possibility of appeal or pardon.

Ben Gvir celebrated the passing of the first reading by handing out sweets in the Knesset. He wore a yellow noose pin during hearings.



3/ Methods of execution include hanging, lethal injection, or the electric chair. The executioner's identity will remain confidential and protected, allowing for full criminal immunity.

4/ Condemned prisoners would be held in separate facilities with severely restricted access:

- Visits limited to "authorized parties" only
- Lawyers can only communicate via video — no in-person contact

5/ The bill specifically targets Palestinians convicted of killing Israelis for "nationalistic or racist" motives — language that by design excludes Israeli settlers who kill Palestinians. This codifies a two-tiered justice system, just like every other Israeli law.

6/ The bill would apply retroactively to those accused of involvement in October 7, classifying their actions as "genocide" under Israeli law — making death sentences mandatory, which essentially legalizes the killings happening now against Palestinian prisoners.

7/ Context: At least 110 Palestinians have died in Israeli custody since January 2023. Rights groups document systematic torture, starvation, violent sexual abuse, and medical abuse and neglect across all Israeli prison facilities.

8/ This act of savagery is aimed at legalizing the killing of prisoners and exonerating their executioners. Zionists love to claim that Israel hasn't executed anyone since Nazi officer Adolf Eichmann in 1962. Now they want to begin again, killing only Palestinians.

9/ The bill has passed its first reading (39-16). Two more readings are required to become law. The next vote is expected soon.

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
